A1 Eaton Socon Bypass Renewal Scheme

On behalf of the Highways Agency I am writing to inform you of a major resurfacing scheme starting shortly on the A1 Eaton Socon Bypass.

We will be resurfacing both carriageways of the A1 from the A428 Wyboston Junction to Hail Bridge, just north of the B645 Hail Weston Junction.

The works are programmed to commence on the evening of Friday 4th September 2009 and, weather permitting, are expected to take approximately 15 weeks to complete.

Phase 1 – Southbound Carriageway Works (4th September to mid November)

This phase will involve the complete closure of the southbound carriageway and slip roads between the B645 junction and the Wyboston junction at the following times:

Monday to Thursday nights:	8.00pm to 6.00am
Weekends:	9:00pm Fridays through to midday Sundays Midnight Sundays to 6.00am Mondays

Southbound traffic will be diverted off the A1 onto the A14 eastbound to Godmanchester and from there down the A1198 to Caxton Gibbet. Traffic will then follow the A428 back to the A1 at Wyboston.

During this phase, the northbound carriageway will remain open but will be reduced to one lane.

Phase 2 – Northbound Carriageway Works (mid November to approx 21st December)

The second phase of the works will involve the complete closure of the northbound carriageway between Wyboston and the B645 junction at the following times:

Monday to Thursday nights:	8.00pm to 6.00am
Weekends:	9:00pm Fridays through to 6.00am Mondays

Northbound traffic will follow the same diversion route as described above but in the opposite direction.

The A1 slip road at the B645 (Little Paxton) will be open to traffic wishing to enter the A1 northbound. During the works there will be a 50mph speed restriction in place.

Access will be maintained where possible for Emergency Services.

There will inevitably be some noise generated by the works and any noisy operations that need to be undertaken during the night-time works will be completed as early as possible each evening.

We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause but delays are expected, especially at the weekends. CarillionWSP will endeavour to keep delays to a minimum but drivers are advised to allow extra time for their journeys or seek alternative routes where possible.
