(*) In computing any period of time for this purpose, Saturday, Sunday, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Good Friday, Bank Holiday or day appointed for public thanksgiving or mourning must be disregarded.

♠ Where a casual vacancy occurs within six months before the day on which the Councillor whose office is vacant would regularly have retired, the preceding words of this paragraph should be deleted.

Note: Notice of the vacancy must be given by posting this Notice in some conspicuous place or places within the area of the authority and in such other manner as appears to the authority to be desirable for giving publicity to the Notice. This must be done in a case where the local authority declare the office to be vacant, immediately after the declaration; and in any other case, as soon as practicable after the date on which the vacancy is deemed to have occurred.
