A message from Elaine McCarthy, Churchwarden

Dear Fellow Hail Westoners,

As the Reverend Canon Nicki Bland, has now retired from being our Parish Priest, and we are officially in a Vacancy, it has fallen to me as Churchwarden, to write a piece for our newsletter, explaining what will happen next.

Firstly, Rev'd Nicki will be a very hard act to follow. We wish her every success in her new life and express our heartfelt thanks for all that she has done for St. Nicolas' Church and Hail Weston Community over the years.

The Churchwardens and LLMs of the Benefice have already had several meetings in preparation for the appointment of our new priest. It is a complex and lengthy process, to ensure that the correct person is appointed, and who will best suit our needs. We are currently finalising our Parish Profiles. We have cover for the services until the end of December so that we can continue to offer the same Church services, during the Vacancy until the end of this year.

From the Diocese Website - regarding vacancies:

'When a vicar or rector resigns or retires, it is important for everyone involved to think carefully about the future. The views of the parish, deanery and Diocese are all taken into consideration, and it is often wise for there to be a period of time between the last incumbent leaving, and a new appointment being made.

The Archdeacon's and Bishop's offices manage the vacancy process together and will decide whether a new incumbent will be appointed, or whether it would be better to put in place a priest in charge.
